WOMEN'S LEGAL SERVICES EXPRESS IMMENSE CONCERN OVER PETITION TO ERODE WOMEN'S RIGHTS IN THE NORTHERN TERRITORY

Specialist Women's Legal Services in the Top End, Big Rivers and Central Australia & Barkly Regions express immense concern over the tabling of a petition in the Parliament of the Northern Territory yesterday evening to revoke amendments to 2021 legislation that gave Territory women access to abortion options equal to women across the country.

The *Termination of Pregnancy Law Reform Act 2017* (NT) was further reformed in 2021 to align the Northern Territory to national professional standards and legislation in other jurisdictions enabling reasonable, safe and equitable access to termination of pregnancy.

The legislation provides security of choice and options to Territory women in a jurisdiction where women's rights continue to be eroded by gender-based violence.

We urge the Public Account Committee to <u>not</u> refer the petition to the Assembly for debate and send a strong message to Territory women that they deserve equitable access to reproductive rights, irrespective of their home address.
